Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to on the subject cited above and to say that it has come to the notice of this Commission that the claim & objections filed by the general public are not being disposed of by the District Electoral Officers (P) in time as prescribed by the Commission, resultantly many litigations arises. Despite this, it has also come to the notice that while printing the final voters list the names of some of the voters are being got printed in the voters list of different ward which also creats litigations.

- 2. In order to curb these practices, you are advised to strictly direct all the District Electoral Officers (Panchayat) to dispose of all the claims and objections on or before the date prescribed by this Commission i.e. 31.05.2010 and also while making the printing of final voters list, it shall be ensured that the name of person has been got printed in the voters list of his/her concerned ward.
- 3. As provided in para 14 of the Notification No.SEC/4E-II/2010/1616, dated 05.05.2010, it shall be ensured that two copies of the voters list finally published on 07.06.2010 have been supplied free of cost to all the recognized political parties in the State of Haryana.
