No. SEC/1ME/2009/20 Whereas consequent upon the death of Sh. Rajesh Kumar S/o Sh. Bishaswer Dass, Member, Ward No. 27, Municipal Council, Kaithal, District Kaithal on 21.5.2009, a vacancy in ward No. 27 of Municipal Council, Kaithal has occurred.

2. And Whereas Section 15 of the Haryana Municipal Act, 1973 read with rule 67 of the Haryana Municipal Election Rules, 1978 provides that election to fill a vacancy occurring by the death, resignation or removal or any other reason of any member, the vacancy shall be filled up with in the six months of the occurrence of such vacancy in accordance with the provisions of the Act and the Rules.

3. Now, therefore, in exercise of power vested under clause(1) of the Article 243 ZA of the Constitution of India, Section 3A of the Haryana Municipal Act, 1973 and rule 19(1) the Haryana Municipal Elections Rules, 1978 and all other powers enabling me in this behalf, I , Chander Singh, State Election Commissioner, Haryana, hereby prescribe the following election programme for the conduct of bye election of ward No. 27 of Municipal Council, Kaithal, District Kaithal.

(5)	Date on which the nomination papers shall be scrutinized under Rule 19(2)(iii)	31/10/2009 (Saturday)
(6)	Last date for withdrawal of candidature by a candidate under Rule 19(2)(vi)	3/11/2009 (Tuesday) Between 11.00 A.M. to 3.00 P.M.
(7)	Date on which symbols shall be allotted to the contesting candidates.	3/11/2009 (Tuesday) After 3.00 P.M.

(13)	Date on which the election result would be declared.	Immediately, after the account of votes recorded, received from the Presiding Officers of the Polling Stations of the constituency(ward) in Form 18 is consolidated by the Returning Officer
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4. The Returning Officer shall publish the above election programme on 20.10.2009 by notices posted at their office, at the office of the Deputy Commissioner, at the offices of the Municipal Council and at such other conspicuous places in the Municipal area of the Municipal Council in which the election would be held as may be determined by him in this behalf under Rule 20 of the Haryana Municipal Election Rules, 1978.

5. The State Election commission further directs that immediately after the expiry of the period within which candidatures may be withdrawn under Rule 28 of the Haryana Municipal Elections Rules, 1978, the concerned Returning Officer shall prepare in Hindi the lists of contesting candidates, that is to say, lists of candidates who have been included in the lists of validly nominated candidates, and those who have not withdrawn their candidatures within the prescribed period. The lists shall be caused to be posted at the some conspicuous place, in the office of the Returning Officer or at the Municipal Council office.

6. The State Election Commission further directs that the concerned Returning Officer or the Assistant Returning Officer as the case may be, shall at every stage prepare the notices of the nominations containing descriptions similar to those contained in the nomination papers both of the candidates and the proposes, the lists of candidates whose nomination papers have been rejected, the list of validly nominated candidates, the notices of withdrawal of candidatures and the lists of contesting candidates, and affix the same at some conspicuous places, at the notice board of their offices and at the office of the Municipal Council and shall submit one copy thereof to the State Election Commission directly at every stage and one copy through the Deputy Commissioner.

7. The State Election Commission further directs that the counting of votes polled at the elections to the seat of Member of Municipal Council shall be taken up at the respective polling stations on the date of poll immediately after the close of the poll. The details(Accounts) of votes polled at each polling station shall be prepared in Part-II of Form 18 by the Presiding Officer and forwarded to the Returning Officer for consolidation of counting votes on Form 8 mentioning therein the total number of valid votes polled in favour of each candidates on each polling station and declare the candidate who is found to have been obtained largest number of votes elected as Member from the ward.

8. The State Election Commission further directs that after the declaration of result of elections under Rule 62, the Returning Officers shall forthwith post a copy of return (i.e. Form 8- Consolidation of account of the counted ballot papers) in a conspicuous place at his office and send with a copy thereof to the Deputy Commissioner, who shall immediately forward the names of the candidates elected

to the State Election Commissioner, Haryana for notifying the same in official gazette. The Deputy commissioners shall ensure that the names and other particulars of the elected candidates should be the same as are recorded in the nomination paper.

No. SEC/1ME/2009/15 Whereas, The state Government (Urban Local Bodies Department) vide its notification NO. 4/69/00-3C1 dated 31 7.2009 has published the delimitation of wards of Municipal Council, Bahadurgarh. Therefore, after the publication of delimitation of wards, this Commission vide its notification No. SEC/2E/2009/5509, dated 03.08.2009 had issued the programme for the preparation of Electoral Rolls of above said Municipal Council, according to which the final publication of electoral rolls was done on 30.09.2009

2. And Whereas as per provisions contained in clause (a) of sub section (1) of Section 12 of the Haryana Municipal Act, 1973, an election to constitute a Municipality shall be completed before the expiry of its duration.

3. Now, therefore, in exercise of power vested under clause (1) of the Article 243 ZA of the Constitution of India, Section 3A of the Haryana Municipal Act, 1973 and rule 19(1) the Haryana Municipal Elections Rules, 1978 and all other powers enabling me in this behalf, I, Chander Singh, State Election Commissioner, Haryana, hereby prescribe the following election programme for the conduct of elections of all ward of Municipal Council, Bahadurgarh, district Jhajjar:-

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4. The Returning Officer shall publish the above election programme on 20.10.2009 by notices posted at their office, at the office of the Deputy Commissioner, at the offices of the Municipal Council and at such other conspicuous places in the Municipal area of the Municipal Council in which the election would be held as may be determined by him in this behalf under Rule 20 of the Haryana Municipal Election Rules, 1978.

5. The State Election commission further directs that immediately after the expiry of the period within which candidatures may be withdrawn under Rule 28 of the Haryana Municipal Elections Rules, 1978, the concerned Returning Officer shall prepare in Hindi the lists of contesting candidates, that is to say, lists of candidates who have been included in the lists of validly nominated candidates, and those who have not withdrawn their candidatures within the prescribed period. The lists shall be caused to be posted at the some conspicuous place, in the office of the Returning Officer or at the Municipal Council office.

6. The State Election Commission further directs that the concerned Returning Officer or the Assistant Returning Officer as the case may be, shall at every stage prepare the notices of the nominations containing descriptions similar to those contained in the nomination papers both of the candidates and the proposes, the lists of candidates whose nomination papers have been rejected, the list of validly nominated candidates, the notices of withdrawal of candidatures and the lists of contesting candidates, and affix the same at some conspicuous places, at the notice board of their offices and at the office of the Municipal Council and shall submit one copy thereof to the State Election Commission directly at every stage and one copy through the Deputy Commissioner.

7. The State Election Commission further directs that the counting of votes polled at the elections to the seat of Member of Municipal Council shall be taken up at the respective polling stations on the date of poll immediately after the close of the poll. The details (Accounts) of votes polled at each polling station shall be prepared in Part-II of Form 18 by the Presiding Officer and forwarded to the Returning Officer for consolidation of counting votes on Form 8 mentioning therein the total number of valid votes polled in favour of each candidates on each polling station and declare the candidate who is found to have been obtained largest number of votes elected as Member from the ward.

8. The State Election Commission further directs that after the declaration of result of elections under Rule 62, the Returning Officers shall forthwith post a copy of return (i.e. Form 8- Consolidation of account of the counted ballot papers) in a conspicuous place at his office and send with a copy thereof to the Deputy Commissioner, who shall immediately forward the names of the candidates elected to the State Election Commissioner, Haryana for notifying the same in official gazette. The Deputy commissioners shall ensure that the names and other

particulars of the elected candidates should be the same as are recorded in the nomination paper.
