Subject: - Municipal Elections-Nomination papers reg.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to the subject cited above and to inform you that queries are being received from the different quarters regarding documents to be filed by the proposer of a contesting candidate with the nomination form. In this regard your attention is invited towards sub-rule (3) of rule 21 of the Haryana Municipal Election Rules, 1978 and serial No.5 of chapter VI of the Hand Book for the Returning Officers and clarification is given as under:-

- i. That the proposer should submit no dues certificate from Electricity Board, Cooperative Bank and other NDCs which are required to be submitted by the contesting candidate. A copy of his educational qualification certificate should also be submitted by the proposer.
- ii. No affidavit in form 1C and 1D is required from the proposer. However, the proposer should submit an affidavit/declaration that he fulfils all conditions for the election of municipality and is not suffering from any disqualification provided in the Haryana Municipal Act, 1973 and the Haryana Municipal Election Rules, 1978, to the satisfaction of the Returning Officer.
- iii. That only a person who is eligible to contest the municipal election can be a proposer of any candidate of any category from any ward of the municipality.

2. You are requested to bring the above said clarifications in the notice of all the Returning Officers and also give wide publicity to the above clarification.
