I am directed to refer to the subject cited above and to say that the State Election Commission, Haryana has issued the notifications for the conduct of the General Elections of the seat of Mayor and members of all the wards of Municipal Corporation, Ambala, Panchkula & Sonapat and President and Members of Municipal Council Rewari, Municipal Committee, Sampla (Rohtak), Dharuhera (Rewari) & Ukalana (Hisar) and Bye- elections of W. No. 07 of Municipal Committee, Indri (Karnal), W. No. 13 of Bhuna (Fatehabad), W. No. 12 of Rajound (Kaithal), W. No. 14 of Municipal Council, Fatehabad and W. No. 29 of Municipal Council, Sirsa vide

Notification No. SEC/1ME/2020/3165 and SEC/1ME/2020/3184 dated 03.12.2020. The Commission has received references from various quarters regarding allotment and use of rest houses and other Government accommodations during election period. The Commission after considering various issues involved and taking into account all relevant factors has decided that the Rest houses, Dak bungalows or other Government accommodation may be used by the members of any political party or candidates in a fair manner on the charges fixed by the authority concerned, but no party or candidate shall use or be allowed to use such accommodation (including premises appertaining thereto) as a campaign office or for holding any public meetings for the purposes of election propaganda.
